Emergency Water System Generators
Project Scope

The City of Gatesville intends to provide emergency power components at main infrastructure within its system. The following is a summary of the system and proposed improvements:

Water is pumped from Belton Lake to the Gatesville WTP. It is then pumped from the WTP to the southern limits of the City, including Booster Pump Station (BPS) #1. No improvements are included in this project for these components.

From the south (BPS#1) water enters the City's southern limits. The main line along SH 36 conveys water to Mountain Ground Storage Tank (GST), Elevated Storage Tank (EST) #5 and GST #3. The "Y" Fill Valve opens to allow the flow to split to the west where it is conveyed to 23rd Street EST and GST #7.

Mountain GST sits at an elevation that it can backpressure the other components within the City and provides water service to the Mountain Pressure Plane which currently consists of the area around the Wal-Mart.

BPS#5 provides service to the BP#5 Pressure Plane which consists of the east and west sides of SH 36 to just south of the prisons.

BPS# 3 takes flow from GST #3 and provides service to BP#3 Pressure plane in the northern part of the City.

23rd Street EST provides service to the main portion of the City along US 84 and to the north and south of it.

GST #7 allows BPS#7 to pressurize the BPS #7 Pressure Plane providing water service to the western portion of the City and beyond.

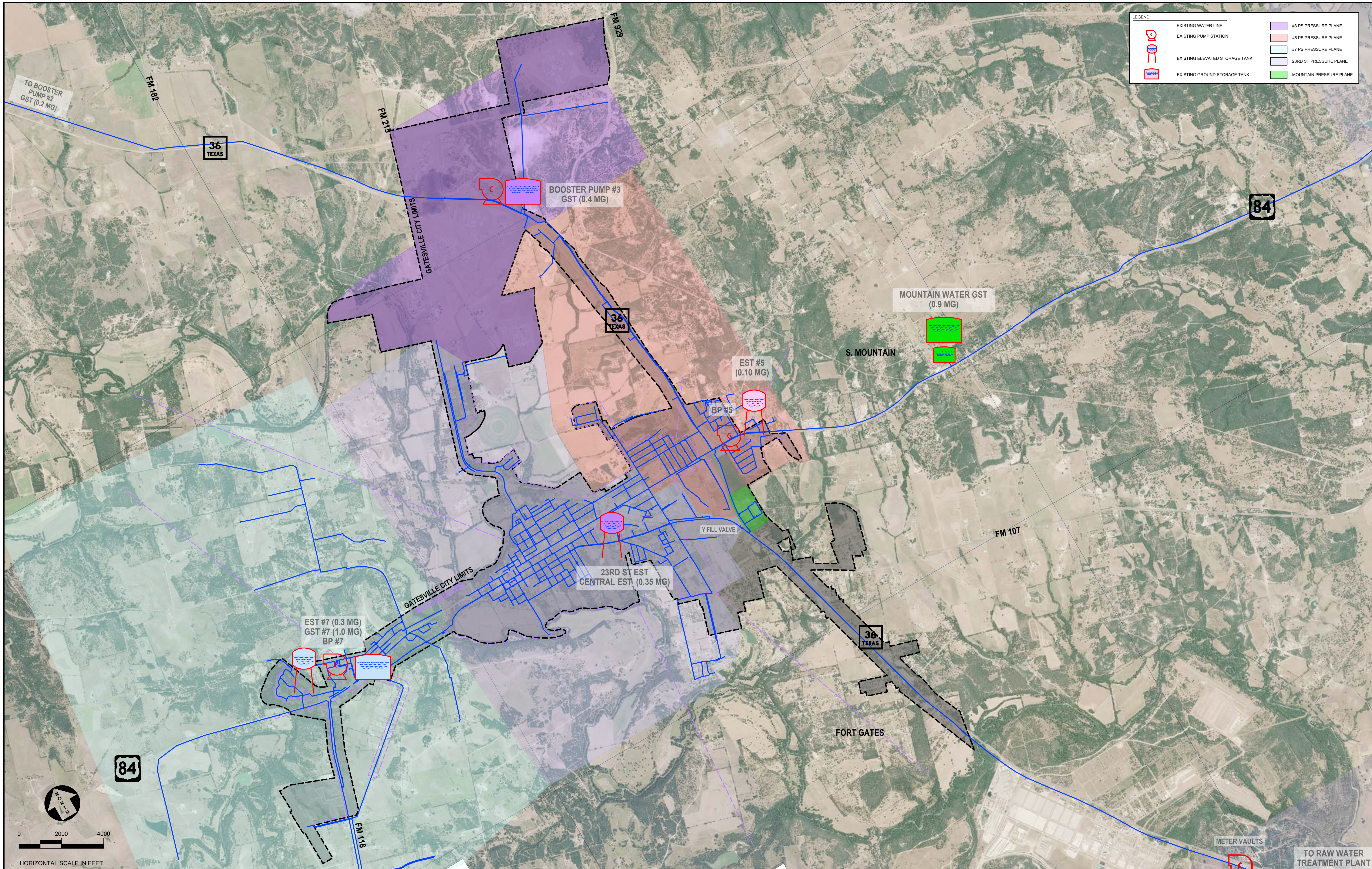
Proposed Improvements include:

1. Permanent Generators to provide emergency power for water booster pumps at the following locations within the City with the areas benefitted noted (and shown on the attached map):
 - a. BPS #3 → BP#3 Pressure Plane
 - b. BPS #5 → BP#5 Pressure Plane
 - c. BPS # 7 → BP#7 Pressure Plane

2. Solar Powered Backup consisting of solar panels, charger/inverter and batteries for SCADA / instrumentation, controls and valves at ESTs, GSTs and control valves at the following locations:
 - a. "Y" Fill Valve → 23rd Street Pressure Plane to BP#7 Pressure Plane
 - b. 23rd Street EST → 23rd Street Pressure Plane and BP#7
 - c. Mountain GST → Mountain Pressure Plane and potential to backfeed BP#5 and 23rd St Pressure Planes.
